

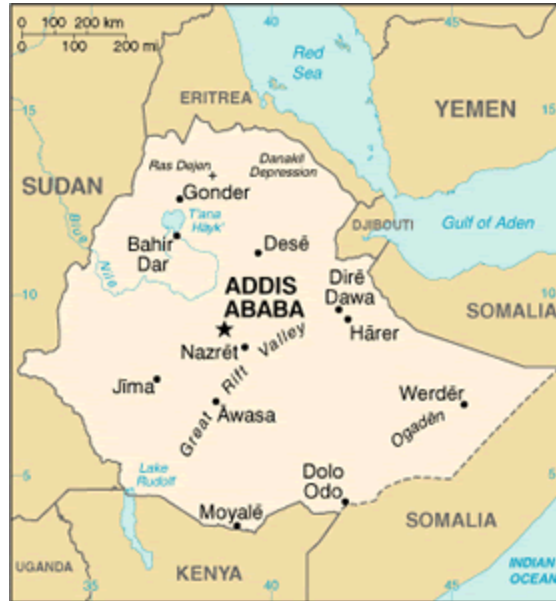

General Facts

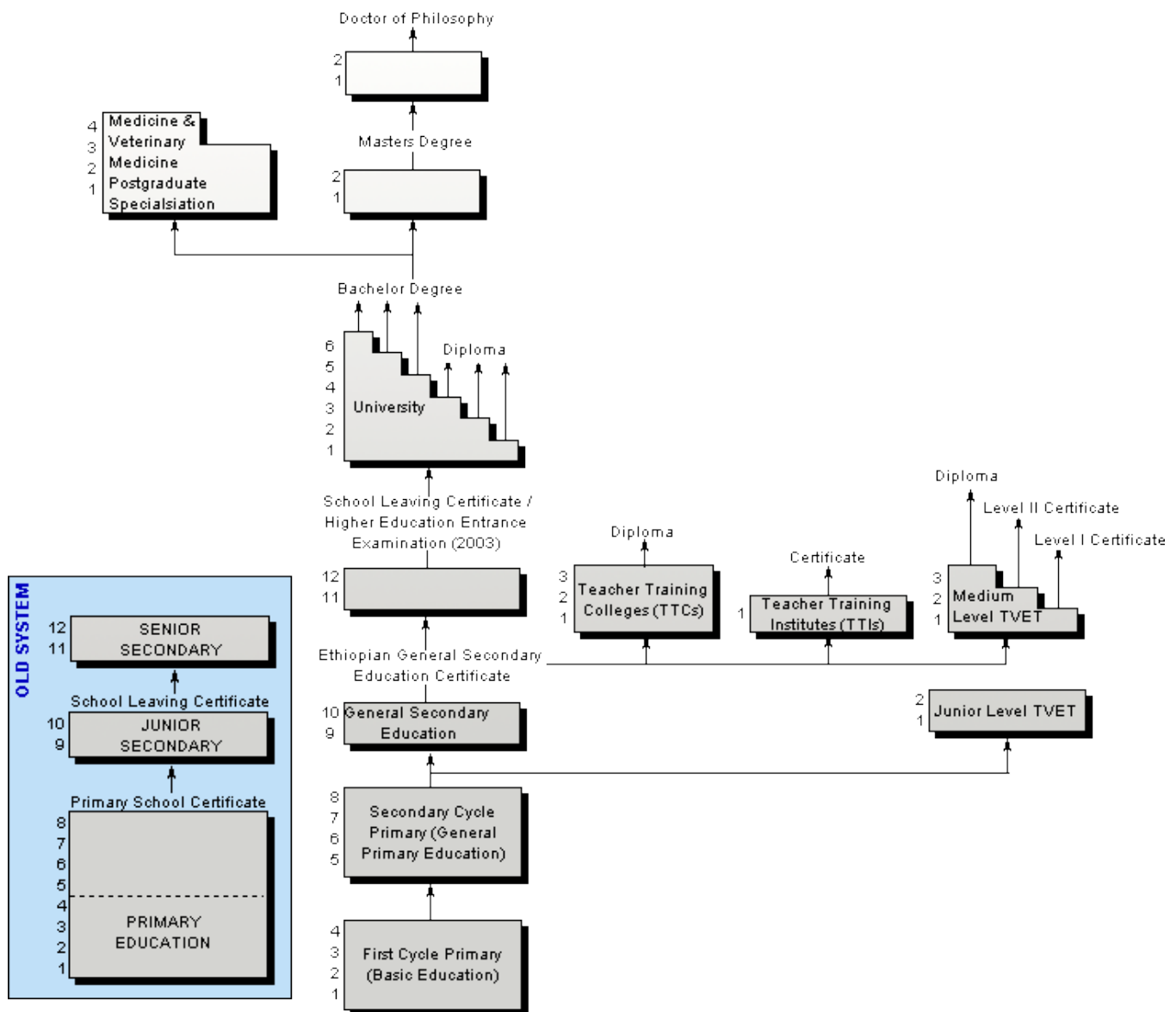


- Ethiopian calendar year - The Ethiopian year consists of 365 days, divided into twelve months of thirty days each plus one additional month of five days (six in leap years). Ethiopian New Year's falls on September 11 and ends the following September 10, according to the Gregorian (Western) calendar. From September 11 to December 31, the Ethiopian year runs seven years behind the Gregorian year; thereafter, the difference is eight years. Hence, the Ethiopian year 1983 began on September 11, 1990, according to the Gregorian calendar, and ended on September 10, 1991. This discrepancy results from differences between the Ethiopian Orthodox Church and the Roman Catholic Church as to the date of the creation of the world.

- History - In 1974, a military junta, the Derg, deposed Emperor Haile SELASSIE (who had ruled since 1930) and established a socialist state. the regime was finally toppled in 1991 by a coalition of rebel forces, the Ethiopian People's Revolutionary Democratic Front (EPRDF). A border war with Eritrea late in the 1990's ended with a peace treaty in December 2000.
- **Religions:**
Christian 60.8% (Orthodox 50.6%, Protestant 10.2%), Muslim 32.8%, traditional 4.6%, other 1.8% (1994 census)
- **Languages:**
Amarigna 32.7%, Oromigna 31.6%, Tigrigna 6.1%, Somaligna 6%, Guaragigna 3.5%, Sidamigna 3.5%, Hadiyigna 1.7%, other 14.8%, English (major foreign language taught in schools) (1994 census)

- Education is free at the primary and secondary level
- Compulsory education lasts 8 years (age 14):
 - 4 years of Basic Education (1st cycle)
 - 4 years of General Primary Education (2nd cycle)

The AAU Registrar system is responsible for managing the academic records of students and is committed to serve the students, alumni and the external community. The registrar system commenced at Addis Ababa University about 52 years ago in 1950 when the University College of Addis Ababa took off with the first batch of 71 students. The number of students went on increasing each year such that those registered during the 2002/2003 academic year added up to 23,000 and the graduates were 4123.

The archives of the Registrar show that close to 200,000 students have been enrolled over the years in one of the University's academic programmes.

The registrar system of the AAU has recently been reorganized to create faculty registrar units in each faculty/college and these have been empowered to handle various functions. Students are therefore directly served at the **Registrar Units of their respective faculty/college** for most of the services they are supposed to get from the Office of the Registrar.

The Office of the Registrar is currently endeavouring to upgrade its work by decentralizing some operations and automating the main activities of the system. The latter is merely beginning. It is hoped that the automation work will computerize the main operations and considerably improve provision of efficient services to AAU students and alumni.

Undergraduate Study

Regular Programme Admissions

The Ministry of Education (MOE) determines the admission of regular students into the various degree and diploma programmes of Addis Ababa University. The admission to newly introduced one -years less programmes is normally based on the results of Ethiopian Higher Education Entrance Certificate Examination (EHEECE) plus transcripts of the preparatory programme, and the Ethiopian School Leaving Certificate Examination (ESLCE) and other recognized external examinations.

External examinations like the General Certificate of Education (GCE), the Cambridge Overseas Examination, the West African School Leaving Certificate and the Oxford Examinations are considered as equivalents to the ESLCE. Applicants holding certificates in any of these examinations must satisfy the same grade point average required on the ESLCE. Other qualifications and/or certificates may be granted equivalence by the MOE.

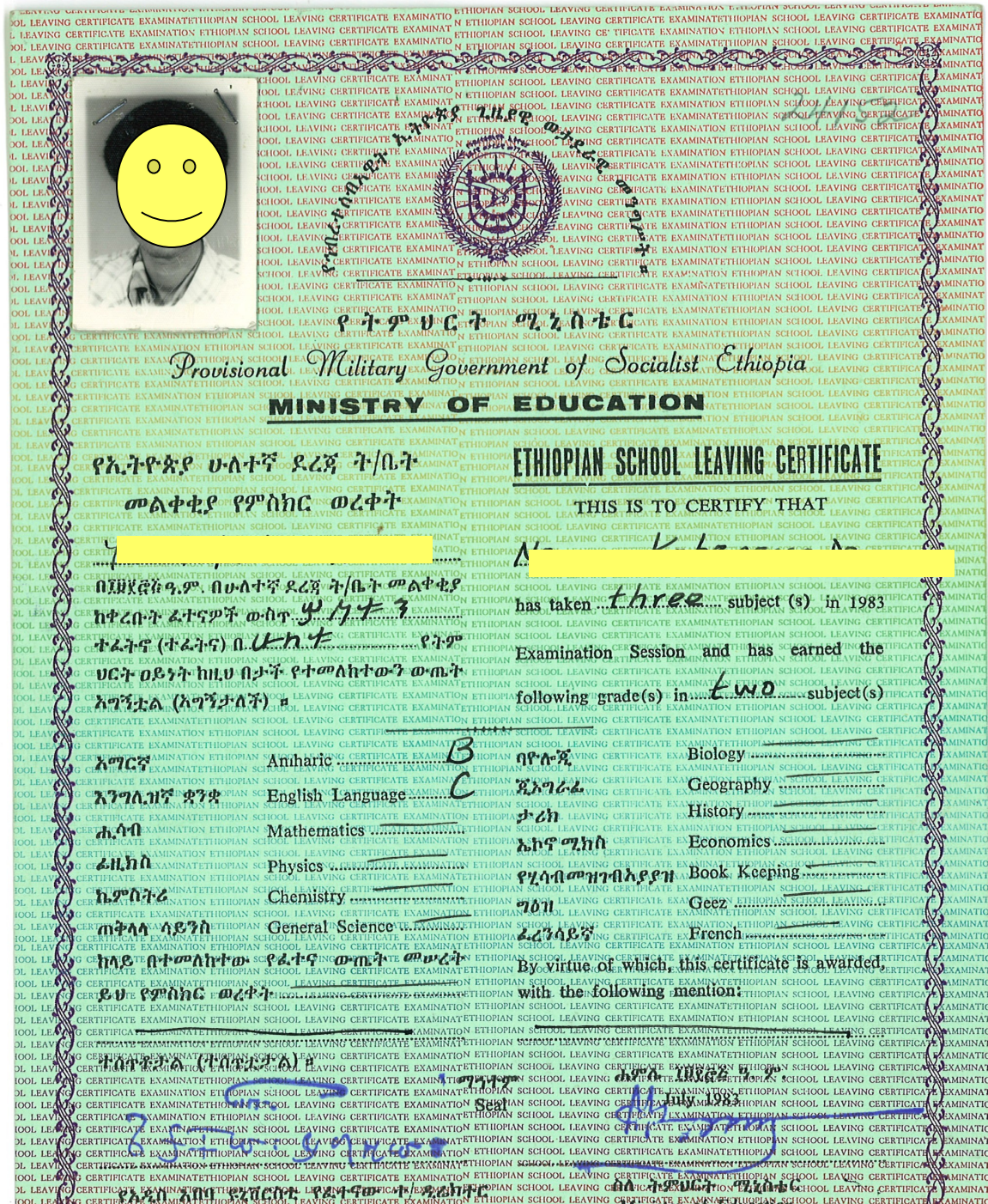

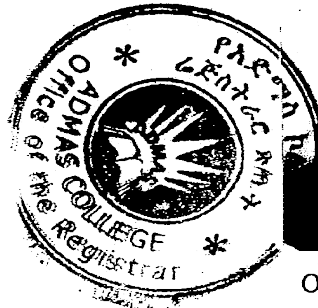
