Degrees



The degrees awarded in the French higher education system are based on the European ladder of Licence, Master, and Doctorat. Degrees are awarded based on the successful completion of a specified number of semesters or years of study, expressed in credits as defined by the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS):

Licence = 6 semesters = 180 ECTS (baccalauréat* + 3 years) Master = 10 semesters = 300 ECTS (baccalauréat + 5 years) Doctorat (PhD) = 16 semesters (baccalauréat + 8 years)

At the core of the French degree system are a set of "national diplomas" that have the same value regardless of the institution that grants them, thanks to the supervision and support provided by the French government.

Please note

- Any foreign student enrolled in a course of higher education at home is eligible to apply for admission to a French institution and may be admitted if he or she meets the established criteria.
- ECTS (European Credit Transfer System): a European system for transferring academic credits within Europe.

Credits, corresponding to an evaluation of the amount of work a course represents within the overall volume of work required for a successful academic year, are assigned to each course. 60 ECTS credits are awarded for a year, 180 for the licence level, and 300 for the master level.
