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Dr Atta hopes to develop strong linkages between Pakistan and US institutions

WASHINGTON, Feb 13 (APP): Chairman Higher Education Commission Dr Atta ur Rehman has expressed the hope for developing strong linkages between Pakistani and American institutions of science and technology as part of efforts to produce experts who can help spur industrial growth and propel the country towards a knowledge-based economy.

Addressing gatherings of students, academia and scientists at Georgetown University and American Association for the Advancement of Science, Dr Atta ur Rehman also highlighted some of the far-reaching reforms Pakistan has introduced to revamp its higher education system on modern lines.

Pakistan, he said, desires to send about 3000 Pakistani students to the United States in the coming years for training at Masters, PhD, post-doctoral and technical levels in wide-ranging fields including basic, applied and social sciences.

Dr Atta, who is in the US capital to co-chair the inaugural meeting of Pakistan-US Science and Technology Committee on Tuesday, suggested that Pakistan and the United States could jointly sponsor a programme, spanning over next ten years to train the Pakistani students.

Dilating on the linkages programme, he said Pakistan has already established 50 linkages with British universities. The country has the world's largest US \$ 150 million Fulbright programme under which 640 Pakistani students would be sent to Ivy League universities of America over next five years in various

fields of social, applied and basic sciences.

Speaking of the initiative to establish nine high-tech universities, he said these would be established in collaboration with Germany, France, Sweden, South Korea, Japan, Austria, Italy and China. These institutions, two of which commence their sessions later this year, will have world class examination systems and award internationally acknowledged degrees to students.

"These will be closely connected with the needs of industry of today and tomorrow and promote the development of a knowledge economy."

These universities will have some 50,000 students enrolled and produce about 10,000 highly qualified engineers every year.

"As a result of this programme we hope to provide a large number of suitably qualified engineers in sectors including telecom, steel, metallurgy, ship building, information technology, computer, software, sports, surgical and automobile industries as well as in the agriculture sector for improving crop yields."

He was confident that the highly qualified experts would help bring about a significant increase in Pakistan's GDP, which currently is largely dependent on textiles.

"We hope to move into engineering goods and services sector in a much bigger manner," he said.

He said problems like extremism and terrorism can be stamped out in the long-term through education and enlightenment and not through the use of force.

"The problem of terrorism in the world can be fought through enlightenment and education," he emphasized, while noting that a mix of poverty, lack of education, frustration and deprivation breed extremism.

At the same time, Dr Atta underscored that the world needs to address the root causes of extremism and terrorism. He particularly pointed out the need to resolve lingering conflicts like Palestine and Kashmir.

Speaking at the Georgetown university event, jointly organized by the Pakistani American Leadership Center, Dr Atta ur Rehman agreed with a participant on the need for grooming creative abilities of students at early stages. However, he added, that improving the quality of education at college and university levels will produce teachers, who can impart quality education to the new generation.

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
